

Knowing a Sovereign God

God is sovereign, which means He has unlimited power and authority. Dr. David Jeremiah explains, “God is God, elevated above the highest authority in all the universe and possessing not only infinite power but infinite right, rule and reign.”

Biblical Teachings:

- 1) **God is often referred to as Sovereign Lord** (Genesis 15:2; Duet 3:24; Psalms 73:28; Is 50:9; Luke 2:28-30; Acts 4:24; Rev 6:10).
- 2) **God is also referred to as “King of kings, and Lord of lords”** (I Timothy 6:15-16; Rev 17:14, 19:16).
- 3) **God is sovereign and He is in charge of everything!** (I Chron 16:31, 29:10-13; Psalms 22:28, 33:11, 50:11-12, 99:1, 103:19, 115:3, 135:6).
- 4) **Because God is sovereign, we should revere Him** (Proverbs 9:10; I Peter 2:17).
- 5) **Because God is sovereign, we should obey Him** (Genesis 18:25; I Samuel 3:18).
- 6) **Because God is sovereign, we should worship Him** (I Chron 29:10-13; I Timothy 1:17, 6:15-16).
- 7) **Because God is sovereign, we should avoid worshipping false gods** (Exodus 20:1-5; Duet 6:6-10).
